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### Code of Conduct for Members

As a member of City of Bristol Rowing Club you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or the club captain if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training sessions and approved racing kit for competitions, as agreed with the coach/club captain.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Swearing is not acceptable.
- Be respectful of all other club members, their training, and their equipment
- Report all illnesses or injuries at the earliest opportunity so coaches can adapt the training as required.
- Ensure that all incidents or accidents are entered into the club's Accident Report Book
- Ensure that any damage to boats or equipment is reported to the coach on duty.
