The City of Bristol Winter Head race will give competitors the option to race a long (3300m) or short (2300m) course on Bristol's floating harbour. You'll race right through the center of Bristol rowing past the SS Great Britain, the Matthew and Bristol's Amphitheatre.

All competitors should be aware of a new bridge crossing the floating harbour between Castle Park and Finzel's Reach as it presents an additional steering challenge to be aware of during the race and whilst navigating to the marshalling points.

Due to the additional complexity of steering around the new bridge, only experienced crews will be invited to race the long course. Novice and Junior events will be run on the short course but please email us cityofbristolhead@bristolrowing.co.uk if you believe that; you are a senior/masters crews that would prefer to race the short course or you are a novice/junior crew that would prefer to race the longer course and can show the advanced capability of the crew.

Entries close Sunday 29th October 6pm. Draw on Tuesday 31st October 8pm at 7 Henleaze Road, Bristol, BS9 4EX. To be held under the Rules of British Rowing, and British Rowing Rules of Racing will apply. BROE entries only.
